

Family Salvation.

In 1973, I gave certain scriptures to a lovely lady by the name of Norah who worked in a Bible book store in Clearwater, Florida.

She related to me how she had been praying for her husband's salvation for five years, I began to share with her the scriptural way to receive results for anything if you are a believer; especially salvation for those on your heart. With joyful anticipation and praise, she attended to God's Word as directed. Later, she told me that she began to pray for her husband's salvation on November 3, 1973.

She inscribed this date in her Bible by each scripture which I gave her. The following February 28th, her husband was saved and baptized in the Holy Spirit.

The secret of the quick results is trusting God to do the work; this means to keep quiet and not to make one inference about your beliefs or ideas. If inquiries are made, be minimal in your conversations.

God will begin to work right before your eyes bringing you a complete joy when you see Him -hasten His word to perform it---. There is a way and it works, if you believe, for God honours His word and uses the foolish things of the world to confound the wise. (1 Cor. 1:25-28). So, don't falter ... persevere no matter what circumstances come up before your eyes. God is faithful to His Word.

Before I go on, there should be a stipulation set forth here. If the one for whom you are praying has already received the heavenly gift, the Baptism of the Holy Ghost, and yet this one has apparently gone back to the ways of the world, then much, much more effort will have to be taken on your part. Fasting and prayer will break the bands of wickedness.

Not many people in the Bible were able to change God's mind! Two of the very few who are recorded in the Bible were Hezekiah and Ahab they humbled themselves before God and God did change His mind. If you know how wicked Ahab was and that at that time no grace was available, you will have a vivid picture of the mercy of God. God is not willing that any perish. He desires that all men come into salvation. He states, "For I am the Lord, I change not. . ." therefore, His Word cannot change either. (Mt. 24:35). The Word states, "Him that cometh to Me, I will in no wise cast out.---" (Jn. 6:37. Heb. 7:25). So fast and pray for this one to acknowledge the error of his ways and repent of his wrong doing, so the glorious light of the Gospel will draw him back into fellowship with. God. " For with God nothing shall be impossible." (Lk. 1:37)

For Salvation and The Baptism of The Holy Spirit

Use the following verses in each situation, applying them to the person for whom you are praying by putting their name in each scripture. Speak these selected scriptures out loud. If necessary, write them down on a piece of paper and read them to the Lord. (Hosea 14.2). Soon after, you will notice that those scriptures will become a part of you because memorization comes from repeating verses

often.

Step 1 Acts 16:31

Believe - (For family members)

The Word says it, so this belongs to you!

Step 2 Col. 4:2

Door of Utterance

The door of utterance is opened by the Holy Spirit to speak the mystery of Christ by the witness of another (other than yourself). They will plant the seed of the Word in their heart for the Holy Spirit to water and nourish. Then the mystery of Christ will be revealed because their spiritual eyes will have been opened by the Holy Spirit to receive the indwelling Word. If you leave this all to Jesus, He will do a much faster job and in doing so, will bring all the glory to God. Scriptures following and including this step can be used for whomever, as well as family.

Step 3 Mt. 5:6

Hunger and Thirst

Only the Lord Jesus can give them this hunger for spiritual things and more of Him.

Step 4 Jn. 6:44, 14:6

Drawn unto the Father

Drawing power is part of God's omnipotence (all-power). Only God the Father can draw them into submission by His Spirit. (Jn. 1:12-13).

Step 5 Ps. 37:4-5

Committal

This is the key to the success of the whole plan. When someone is committed to the Lord, he must be left in the Lord's hands. If you start fretting, questioning, worrying, you are not trusting God, and you get it back in your hands - God's hands are tied by your unbelief. Faith is believing you receive before you see it. (Heb. 11:6). From this point on, you will see the devil try to work in a stronger, more evident way, if you are around the one you are praying for, because the devil wants you to doubt and waver so your prayer will not be answered, "A merry heart maketh a cheerful countenance: but by sorrow of the heart the spirit is broken." (Prov. 15:13).

Don't let the devil break your spirit! Remember, verbalizing God's promises is joining your faith to your confession. "That the communication of thy faith may become effectual by the acknowledging of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus." (Philemon 6). God has begun His work, so from the day of committal, there is no need to ask anymore, Begin to thank Him each day, repeating each scripture key as you apply it to the person for whom you are praying.

As you repeat the Word each day, you are 'holding fast your profession' (Heb. 4:14b) and believing you have received even before the

evidence is before your eyes and ears. (2 Cor. 4:13). Do not stop thanking God each day in each scripture key until you see the results come forth!
Scripture Keys for Confidence and Assurance (to carry you through).

Ps. 34:1 0b "They that seek the Lord shall not want any good thing." (It certainly is a good thing to desire someone's salvation!)

Ps. 37:4 "Delight thyself also in the Lord,. and He shall give thee the desires of thine heart."

Prov. 10:24b "...the desire of the righteous shall be granted."

Isa. 55:11 "So shall My word be that goeth forth out of My mouth: it shall not return unto me void,..."

Mt. 21:22 "And all things whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive."

Jn. 14:13-14 "Whatsoever ye shall ask in My name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If ye shall ask any thing in My name, I will do it."

Jn. 16:24 ... ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full."

Jn. 15:7 "if ye abide in Me, and My words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you."

Rom. 8:32 "He that spared not His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall he not with Him also freely give us all things?"

Eph. 3:20 "Now unto Him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us,"
(That power is evident when professing God's Word).

Rom. 4:20-21 "He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God; And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform."

Faith Cometh by Hearing and Hearing by The Word of God. Romans 10:17 "But without faith it is impossible to please Him: for he that cometh to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him." (Heb. 11:6). As you use God's Word daily, you are taking God at His word! So many answers to prayer do not come because God will not violate His Word. Faith is a necessary ingredient. By using His Word in prayer and supplication with thanksgiving as instructed herein, God will honour it. Why? One of the reasons is because your faith is being built up as you speak His Word. This is asking in faith. (Rom. 10:17). If you did not believe the Word, you would not be applying it to your prayers. The crying and begging without faith gets no farther than the ceiling in your room. Faith is a gift of God, (Eph. 18) and confessing the

Word brings the faith needed for each situation. As you speak it, the Word becomes flesh in you, bringing belief. Belief activates the miracle-working faith!

HINDRANCES

There can be hindrances to receiving answers to prayer and healings. If you are not seeing results, either you have not persevered long enough or there is a hindrance blocking it. Do not allow doubt to invade your conversation, or into your heart. Believe, and give it time, knowing that God will not let His Word return unto Him void.....

REMEMBER ...

There are immediate answers. "And it shall come to pass that before they call, I will answer; and while they are yet speaking, I will hear." (Isa. 65:24).
is waiting patiently, believing, and thanking God every day for the answer which came the moment you asked, but sometimes we have to wait, like God.. s time and His way of answering may not be the way or time we out the answer will come, for -nothing is impossible with God.(Lk. 18:27; Ezek. 12:21-28).
If there never is an answer, maybe God has a reason for not answering this prayer. Many have had the experience of thanking God that He sees ahead, that if we had knowledge of the future, we would not pray that prayer.
We should not apply this to a salvation request, for "God is not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance." (2 Pet. 19).

Doubt is a robber

Doubt is an outright distrust of the love and care of the Heavenly Father and this is sin. "Cast thy burden upon the LORD, and he shall sustain thee: he shall never suffer the righteous to be moved."

(Ps. 55:22). The devil would like to rob you of every blessing: disbelief, fear, worry, and confusion are all mixed up with doubt. "Fear ye not, stand still, and see the salvation of the Lord, which He will show to you today:..."

(Ex. 14:13). "God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind." (2 Tim. 1:7)
